A Night of Art to Support our Neighbors in Need and An Opportunity to Showcase Your Talent!

On February 6, 2020, St. Vincent de Paul NKY is hosting an art event at New Riff Distillery to raise funds in support of our mission to help our neighbors in need.

The event will feature work from 35 local university students who will create a work of art utilizing materials from one of our St. Vincent de Paul stores. Finished pieces will be showcased and for sale via auction at the event and proceeds will be split between the student and St. Vincent de Paul.

Each student entered will be given a \$20 voucher to purchase merchandise from any of our three stores in Northern Kentucky to turn into a work of art. You can purchase anything you want to be used in your art piece.

We will accept the first 35 entries that will fit into one of our four categories:

- 2D All Media (10 Participants)
- 3D All Media (10 Participants)
- Canvas (10 Participants)
- Costume Design (5 Participants)

Upon entry, students will be asked to provide progress updates according to the following timeline:

- Sign-ups beginning September 23rd through October 4th via a Survey Monkey link. Keep your eyes open for the email containing the link next week!
- Abstract descriptions due October 21st. The first 10 students to submit their abstract descriptions will be featured in our social media posts advertising this event.
- Progress reports due via a work plan or photograph submissions on the following dates:
 - November 22
 - December 20
 - January 17
- Creative Compassion will take place on February 6. Students will be responsible for the display of their piece.

Once spots fill up, we will maintain a waiting list should a student decide to no longer participate or misses a progress update. If a spot opens up, students on the waiting list will be notified that they have an opportunity to participate.
